

General Guidelines for Interior Insecticide Spraying: Wasps and Flying Insects

The interior or indoors area to be treated must be ready on time for the spraying as per the agreed appointment or arrangement. Delays may disrupt the technician's working schedule, and this may lead to a reschedule and/or an extra charge. No one except the authorized technicians can be in the premises during the insecticide application.

Preparing your premises as follows, will enable the technicians to provide the most effective treatment, will allow a safe process:

- Within reason, clear goods off the area to be treated (i.e. objects that may interfere with the application of the insecticide).
- Store all exposed or unpackaged food away
- Remove and put children's toys in sealed bags, and store away safely
- Ensure pets are not in the building for the service duration
- Put pet's food in sealed containers, and store away water bowls safely
- Ensure any fish tanks are covered, and the oxygen pump is turned off
- Remove caged birds for the service duration
- Remove or cover sensitive items such as artwork, delicate plants, and electrical screens (TV, computers, and similar appliances) with sheets
- Close all the windows
- Turn off humidifiers and appliances that produce air movement like air conditioners, floor and ceiling fans, and stove and bathroom exhaust fans
- Inform the technician and/or the landlord of any areas that have been recently painted (less than 6 weeks)
- Items removed from kitchen and bathroom may be placed temporarily in a room, and covered with a cloth sheet. These covered items can be returned to their normal place once you have complied with time away from the premises as per the treatment protocol

Immediate actions for the customer after complying with the re-entry time:

- The first step is to ventilate the premises for 15 minutes before staying inside. After this you can get back to the premises but keep ventilation for two more hours. This can be done by opening windows and doors, or through use of air exchange/ventilation systems.
- Be cautious that some wasps or stinging (or biting) flying insects may remain close to treated area for some hours.
- Kitchen counter tops, cutting boards, and fridge and stove top should be washed with soap and warm water prior to placing any items back.



Important Notes:

Multiple applications may be required for achieving a desired wasps or flying insects control when a high infestation is present and/or when the area to be treated has conditions that may interfere with an ideal spraying / treatment, for example, structures blocking the infested spaces.
