

Post Bed Bug Spraying Treatment Guidelines

Immediate actions:

get back to the premises but keep ventilation for two more hours. This can be done by opening windows and or through use of air exchange/ventilation systems. After this you can get back to the premises but keep ventilation for two more hours. This can be done by opening windows and doors, or through use of air exchange/ventilation systems.

Since 1 or 2 extra pesticides treatments MAY BE required, we recommend avoiding unpacking your belongings for a period of at least 6 weeks.

According to Alberta Health Services, it is recommended to use mattress and box spring encasement covers, along with bed leg and furniture leg interceptors. If you are interested in implementing this recommendation, please ask Savvy Pest Control Ltd.

It is highly recommended to use both bed bug detectors and bed leg interceptors in order to monitor the progress of the insecticide spraying treatment. These devices may be installed 1-2 weeks after the last insecticide application (ask Savvy Pest Control Ltd. about when to install the detectors and interceptors since this may vary). If no bed bugs are trapped after 3-4 weeks from the detectors and interceptors installation (the length of this period may change for certain types of detectors, therefore please ask Savvy Pest Control Ltd. for recommendations), then no further insecticide application is required. Nevertheless, a good preventive measure is to inspect existing bed leg interceptors and to place bed bug detectors every 2 - 3 months after an infestation has been controlled, particularly in buildings with a history of bed bug issues.
